## **Team Captains: Please keep these rules for your information**

- 1. Eligibility or tournament qualifications: Any team or individual associated with a ND State USBC and a local Association registered with ND State USBC shall be eligible to enter and participate in the tournament, provided they are actual residents of the state of ND or have been regular members of a local association in the state for 30 days prior to the start of the tournament. This rule applies to all original entrants and substitutes. If at any time, anyone violates this rule, they shall be disqualified and any prize money will be forfeited. Students/Minors who have not attained the age of 18 shall have written consent of their parent or quardian in order to participate.
- 2. ENTRIES ARE DUE to the Tournament Manager BY MARCH 6, 2020, or reservation will be canceled automatically. All entry forms and fees are to be mailed in the same envelope. Teams whose members are wishing to bowl together should send their entry forms together as well. All events must be paid prior to the bowlers first event. An all events entry may be transferred provided the substitute is replacing the original bowler in all 3 events.
- 3. Entries should be mailed to: Duane Wolf 1033 11TH AVE W DICKINSON, ND 58601 with the money order or personal check. A \$30.00 fee will be assessed for all NSF returned checks. NO CASH ACCEPTED. Closing date for all early entries (with entry and fees received) is March 6, 2020 (USBC Rule 310a (2) will apply). Walk-in entries will be accepted at an additional charge of \$5.00 if lanes are available.
- 4. The Tournament Manager will accept reservations on or after January 6, 2020.
- 5. ENTERING AVERAGE: USBC certified averages only will be accepted. The entering average will be the bowlers highest previous final season average, minimum of 21 games, or their last three (3) state tournament composite average, minimum of 21 games, or their present average if it is ten or more pins over their previous seasons average, minimum of 21 games, whichever is higher. A bowler not having an acceptable average under any of the above conditions must bowl scratch. BOWLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFYING THEIR OWN AVERAGE, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. Rule 319 in its entirety is in effect for this tournament. If you have any questions regarding the application of this rule check with the Tournament Manager prior to bowling to avoid possible DISQUALIFICATION. AVERAGE VERIFICATION: Averages from the current bowling season MUST be verified by a current standings sheet from the league. All averages as of March 6, 2020, must have verification sent in with their entry from. If you are using a current season 12 game average as of the date of participation, please provide a current league standing sheet at registration.
- 6. Handicap shall be based on 90% of the difference between the entrant's average and a scratch figure of 210. Each event is to be handicapped on a three (3) game basis.
- 7. The tournament shall consist of a five-person team event, doubles, singles, handicap all events, and scratch all events. Awards shall be given to all State Champions both handicap and scratch in team, doubles and singles in each division. In case of a tie(s), duplicate awards shall be given.
- 8. The tournament will have two (2) divisions as follows:

- 9. Since the tournament allows multiple participation the following provisions apply: teams must change two (2) players to bowl each additional team. A participant may bowl up to three (3) team events. MORE IF THERE IS AN ON SITE SUBSTITUTION. All Events scores will be based on bowlers' first team event appearance.
- 10. Entrants in doubles event shall also enter the singles event, vice versa. Entrants shall bowl in the same order as listed on the entry form. A participant may bowl up to two sets of doubles by changing partners. Entrants bowling doubles twice will also bowl singles twice and be able to place twice in the prize fund. First appearance in the doubles and singles events will count towards their All Events scores. Doubles event will be bowled before the singles event.
- 11. The highest scratch score in the first doubles, first singles and first team event will determine the North Dakota State scratch all events champion. This champion will be eligible to bowl in the USBC Masters tournament. Winner will receive \$600 expense money. Entry fee will be paid, but the winner must participate in the USBC Masters. No alternates will be sent. If the winners age is 50+, they will have the option to bowl the Senior Masters or the Masters tournament.
- 12. There will be an Optional 6-Game Scratch Special Feature event in the tournament. Scratch scores from the bowlers first appearance in Doubles and Singles event will be used to determine the winner.
- 13. In the event a team is unopposed on a pair of lanes, each frame shall be completed on one lane before the next frame is started on the adjoining lane. This rule shall apply to doubles and singles events also.
- 14. An entrant arriving late shall be permitted to bowl, with their score to count, beginning with the frame in which they begin to bowl. If an entrant is late for the doubles event, the entrant present shall bowl their games in the doubles event in order to qualify for all events. Bowlers arriving late will receive zeros for frames missed.
- 15. The automatic scoring will be the official scores. Any dispute or disagreement or any obvious error in scores, shall be immediately referred to and decided by the Tournament Manager. Errors in scoring or in calculations must be reported to a responsible tournament official no later than 24 hours after the game has been played.
- 16. Score sheets must be turned in and signed by the bowlers in order to be eligible for cash prizes.
- 17. A substitute shall take the place in the line-up of the original entrant. The captain, when checking-in shall notify the Tournament Manager or assistant(s) of all substitutions, at least one (1) hour before the scheduled time of bowling. A substitute shall be allowed, if one is available, in case of emergency after a game has started in the team and doubles events only. All substitutions made because of an emergency after a game has started are subject to the approval of the Tournament Manager. The combined scores are to count in either of these events. Only the actual score of the frames bowled shall count if a substitute is not available.

## 18. ENTRY FEE - TEAM, DOUBLES, SINGLES, ALL EVENTS, OPT. 6 GAME SCRATCH SPECIAL FEATURE:

The entry fee shall be \$37.00 per person per event. \$15.00 including tax for the cost of bowling and \$4.75 for tournament expenses, \$17.25 for prize fund, of which 100% will be returned. Entry fee for All Events with handicap and/or scratch is \$5.00 with \$4.50 allocated to the prize fund and \$0.50 to tournament expenses. \$1.00 for every All Events entry will be donated to the Jim Lusk Scholarship Fund. The entry fee for the Optional 6 Game Special Feature is \$10.00 with \$9.50 allocated to the prize fund and \$0.50 to tournament expenses.

- 19. Prize money will be based on one prize for each four (4) entries for team, doubles and singles events in each division. Payoff in All Events and 6-game Scratch Special Feature shall be one of each ten (10) entries.
- 20. Misconduct of any kind will not be permitted. Any member guilty of misconduct may be prevented from beginning or continuing the competition. In such event, a substitute will be allowed if one is immediately available when bowling team or doubles.
- 21. In case of cancellation due to weather, bowlers may reschedule to open dates (if available) or additional weekends may be added. Refunds will be handled in a case by case basis at the discretion of the Tournament Manager. In case of cancellation or emergencies of causes relating thereto or resulting from fire, strikes, lockout, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the ND State USBC, FULL REFUNDS WILL BE GRANTED.
- 22. All bowlers shall be neat, clean and dressed in an appropriate manner. All bowlers shall be dressed modestly and should not reveal one's undergarments. Clothing with inappropriate language or gestures shall not be worn. Any matters not covered, shall be handled by the Tournament Manager. It is the responsibility of the bowler to see that this dress code is followed.
- 23. The ND State USBC board of directors shall have the power to hear and act on disputes, complaints or protests relating to the tournament. The decision of the board is final, except when an appeal is made to USBC. The tournament rules shall be governed by Chapter 6 Tournament Rules. The following do not apply: 301, 302, 309b, 309c, 313, 314, 317, 318, and 323.
