THE FOLLOWING RULES SHALL APPLY TO STATE TOURNAMENT 2022-2023

1. This tournament is open to youth members of the ND USBC State Association only. An out-of-state youth bowler may bowl in the North Dakota State Youth tournament by paying a participation fee of \$30.00 if they do not have a 12-game average in North Dakota. \$30.00 fee would go into the state tournament expense fund.

2. Handicap shall be based on 90% of the difference between the entrant's average and a scratch figure of 220. Each event is to be handicapped on a three (3) game basis.

3. Divisions shall be as follows:
TEAM EVENT – 4-member team – may be all boys, all girls or mixed.
DOUBLES EVENT – may be both boys, both girls or mixed.
SINGLES EVENT – boys division and girls divisions.

4. Events will be Team, Doubles and Singles in the State Tournament. Anyone bowling Doubles must bowl Singles or vice versa. Doubles and Singles must be bowled in sequence and may be bowled TWICE. If a bowler enters doubles a second time, they must enter singles a second time. A bowler bowling doubles twice must change partners for the second appearance. If a bowler places more than once in singles, they are only awarded once (the higher finish). A bowler **may participate 2 times in the Team Event** with the change of at least 2 Team members. First appearance in any event counts towards all-events. Bowlers do not change lanes between doubles and singles.

5. **ENTRY FEE** - \$20.00 per person per event. Lineage - \$14.00, awards - \$2.00, expense - \$4.00. All award fees collected in an event or division of an event to be returned 100% to the participants in that event or division of that event. **Any RETURNED CHECKS will be assessed a \$30.00 returned check fee.**

6. **ALL ENTRIES AND FEES SHALL BE SUBMITTED BY April 3, 2023. Pre-registration is required. Entry forms and fees must be received one week prior to the scheduled bowling shifts or a late fee of \$5.00 will be assessed. Walk-in entries will be accepted up to the last day of the tournament at a \$5.00 late fee, and if lanes are available.**

7. Your entry into the tournament and paying the entry fee holds ND USBC and your local association harmless.

8. Averages for **STATE** shall be the highest USBC league average as of midnight **March 26, 2022** with 21 games or more. If you do not have a 21-game average as of March 26, 2022, you must use a 12-game average as of the date of tournament participation provided it is a minimum of 12 games. Averages must be verified by USBC coach or coordinator. All others must bowl scratch.

9. **STATE** awards will be scholarships and certificates. These will be awarded on a one (1) for each five (5) entries in each class in each division. Certificates will be given to **OVERALL** high scratch games of the tournament in each class for both boys and girls. Scholarships will be administered through SMART – account #86809

10. Scholarships are donated by the North Dakota Charitable Bowling Council. 9-\$100 scholarships will be given for 1st place in Girls and Boys Handicap All Events in each division. 9-\$100 scholarships will be given for 1st place in Girls and Boys Scratch All Events in each division. The scholarships will be administered by the SMART program – account #2232. Any ties will split the scholarship awards.

11. **SUBSTITUTES** must take the place of the original entrant.

12. Members of USBC who conduct themselves in a manner deemed not within the standards expected of youth bowlers while in route to or from or during the State Tournament city shall be suspended immediately by the coach, Tournament Officials or State Officers. They shall be disqualified from further participation in the tournament and reported to USBC for formal suspension from USBC.

13. All bowlers shall be neat, clean, and dressed in an appropriate manner. All bowlers should be dressed modestly and should not reveal one's undergarments. Clothing with inappropriate language or gestures shall not be worn. No caps or headgear should be worn. Any matters not covered shall be handled by the tournament manager. It is the responsibility of both the parents/guardians and the youth bowler to see that this dress code is followed. No cell phones, ipods or personal electronic devices in use while bowling in the tournament. Any extenuating circumstances to be covered by the tournament manager.

14. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to refer any rules to the Tournament Rules Committee and the Board of Directors.

15. **CHECK-IN for bowling is 45 minutes prior to shift time!!**
