Certified by UNITED STATES BOWLING CONGRESS THE FOLLOWING RULES SHALL APPLY TO DOUBLES EXTRAVAGANZA

- This tournament is open to members of the ND USBC State Association who are youth members or adult members who have not yet graduated high school. Participation in all three events of this tournament is required to be eligible for the NDBPA State Youth Bowler of the Year scholarship award.
- 2. Handicap shall be based on 90% of the difference between the entrant's average and a scratch figure of 220. Each event is to be handicapped on a three (3) game basis.
- 3. EVENTS shall be as follows:

<u>AGE EVENT</u> – This event is comprised of bowlers that are in two different age brackets. The doubles must be one bowler 13 and Over and one bowler 12 and Under. Bowlers age is determined as of August 1, 2024.

<u>MYSTERY DOUBLES EVENT</u> Bowlers will enter this division without knowing their partner. They will bowl their 3-game event as singles, and at the end of the tournament, we will draw for their partner.

PICK YOUR PARTNER EVENT - Bowlers will be able to pick any partner they would like to bowl in this event.

4. **DIVISIONS:** All events will be split into two divisions based on Doubles Average:

Division I: 250 & Over Division II: 249 & under

- 5. Bowlers are allowed to bowl the AGE/PICK YOUR PARTNER events more than once. A bowler bowling these events twice must change partners for the second appearance.
- 6. ENTRY FEE \$20.00 per person per event. Lineage \$14.00, awards \$2.00, expense \$4.00. All award fees collected in an event or division of an event to be returned 100% to the participants in that event or division of that event. Any RETURNED CHECKS will be assessed a \$30.00 returned check fee.
- 7. Pre-registration is required. <u>Entry forms and fees must be received one week prior to the scheduled bowling shifts or a late fee of \$5.00 will be assessed.</u> Walk-in entries will be accepted up to the last day of the tournament at a \$5.00 late fee, and if lanes are available.
- 8. Your entry into the tournament and paying the entry fee holds ND USBC and your local association harmless.
- 9. Averages shall be the highest USBC league average of 12 games or more as of January 2, 2025. If you do not have a 12-game average as of that date, you may bowl in the tournament at the discretion of the tournament manager. Averages must be verified by USBC coach or coordinator. All others must bowl scratch.
- 10. Awards will be scholarships and certificates. These will be awarded on a one (1) for each five (5) entries in each division in each Event. \$1,500 ADDED money from ND State USBC Association to be added to the final scholarships. Scholarships will be administered through SMART account #11210
- 11. Scholarships have been donated by the ND Charitable Bowling Council. 12 \$100 scholarships will be awarded to the champions in each event and division. 8 \$25 scholarships will be drawn for at the end of the tournament. The names eligible for the drawing of these scholarships will be any bowlers that DID NOT win any awards in the tournament. The scholarships will be administered by the SMART program account #2232.
- 12. SUBSTITUTES must take the place of the original entry.
- 13. Members of USBC who conduct themselves in a manner deemed not within the standards expected of youth bowlers during the Tournament shall be disqualified from further participation in the tournament and reported to USBC at the discretion of the Tournament Manager.
- 14. All bowlers shall be neat, clean and dressed in an appropriate manner. All bowlers shall be dressed modestly and should not reveal one's undergarments. Clothing with inappropriate language or gestures shall not be worn. No caps or headgear shall be worn. Any matters not covered, shall be handled by the tournament supervisor. It is the responsibility of both the parents/guardians and the youth bowler to see that this dress code is followed. No cell phones, ipods or personal electronic devices in use while bowling in the tournament. Any extenuating circumstances to be covered by the tournament manager.
- 15. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to refer any rules to the Tournament Rules Committee and the Board of Directors.
- 16. CHECK-IN for tournament is 45 minutes prior to shift time!!
